

PRIVACY POLICY

Purpose

Any personal information provided by you to the WGC (e.g. name, address, date of birth and contact details), including information collected, will be protected.

Scope

The WGC does not usually disclose your personal information to any other WGC or person unless there is a legal requirement to do so.

WGC may also disclose personal information to relevant authorities if it reasonably believes that there is a threat to an individual's life, health or safety, or public health or safetv.

If the WGC has reason to suspect that unlawful activity has been, is being or may be engaged in, personal information may be used or disclosed as a necessary part of any investigation and reporting to relevant persons or authorities

The WGC is subject to the provisions of the Privacy Amendment (Enhancing Privacy Protection) Act 2012. The Act contains 13 Australian Privacy Principles (APPs) that set the standards for the handling of personal information.

Definitions

Responsibilities

The WGC has a commitment to privacy and the safeguarding of member, visitor and staff personal information.

Procedure

The WGC may disclose your information to third parties that provide services under contract to the WGC. These contracts require the third party to keep your personal information confidential and secure.

You have a right to access any personal information that the WGC may hold about you, including a right of correction of your information.
